Request clarification of government answer. Can you define the scope of work which is to be performed by the 12 man-years of effort or in lieu of a defined scope provide the level of experience or expertise of the intended resources for the 12 man-years?

At this time, we are unable to provide a defined scope of work which is to be performed by the 12 man-years of effort. The test and evaluation engineering function involves troubleshooting whole process lines and individual equipment components and control system software. This work requires extensive experience with chemical demilitarization process equipment or process equipment of similar function and complexity. Based on past experience we are providing the following labor categories which we will use for evaluation purposes.

For evaluation purposes assume the following labor categories:

- 2 each - Mechanical Engineers (structural/welding, Hydraulic)
- 1 each - Automation Engineer
- 1 each - Electrical Engineer
- 8 each - Engineering Technicians as follows:
  - 4 Mechanics
  - 2 Process
  - 2 Automation

Use your average labor rate for each labor category.
