ADDITIONAL SOLICITATION CLAUSES

SECTION L DELIVERY PERFORMANCE INFORMATION AND OTHER REQUIRED INFORMATION

L-3 Offerors shall submit the following information for ALUMINUM POWDER, TYPE III, GRADE F, NSN: 6810-00-628-3382 as a part of their proposal:

a. **Information to be submitted:** Offerors shall provide Best Value information by addressing each factor Identified in the solicitation. The offerors must provide information in sufficient detail to allow the Government to make best value assessment of the offeror's experience in manufacturing various types and grades of Aluminum Powder (or similar material) within the past three years together with quantities manufactured and whether contract delivery schedules were met. To verify information, offerors shall submit points of contact (including name, phone number and organization) for each order. Evaluation will be based on price, technical acceptability and delivery performance. Lowest price, technically acceptable offers will be evaluated based on recent, relevant delivery performance history for like and similar materials to determine the best value to the Government.

(1) Recent is defined as occurring within the past three (3) years prior to the solicitation's initial closing date. However, the Government has the right to consider information regarding contractor performance up to the date of award.

(2) Relevant is defined as having previously produced like or similar materials. Like or similar material is defined as material that has been produced utilizing similar manufacturing processes, essential skills and unique techniques needed to produce aluminum powder. The Government reserves the right to determine whether materials are like or similar and whether production quantities apply to the current requirement for evaluation purposes. Offerors shall provide a narrative explanation of how/why they believe like or similar materials manufactured are relevant.

b. Any area of the offer requiring clarification will be referred to the Contracting Officer for resolution. The Contracting Officer reserves the right to contact offerors for clarification without opening discussions. The Government anticipates awarding a contract without discussions. The offeror shall also provide Best Value information for key subcontractors that he has identified. Best value data shall be submitted in an original and one copy.

c. Price: The offeror shall submit a firm fixed price in Schedule B of the solicitation. Also, the offeror may submit a separate price for the evaluated option clause in Section I of the solicitation. If the offeror does not quote an option price, the price offered in schedule B for item 0001 shall be the price used for evaluation/award of any option quantities. Prices offered for the basic contract quantity and the 150% evaluated option will be used to determine the total evaluated price.

d. Delivery Performance: The offeror shall provide information regarding recent, relevant delivery performance (for similar items) in the areas of timeliness of deliveries. The offeror must provide information for deliveries made, deliveries scheduled to be made, and deliveries re-scheduled to be made during the 3-year period of performance. Include all supporting information for verification purposes concerning all of these covered deliveries, even though this supporting information may precede the period defined as recent above. The offeror should provide original contract schedule as well as actual deliveries. If there was a slippage, the offeror shall provide all pertinent information regarding the slippage. If the offeror accelerated deliveries or increased production rates to meet the Governments' needs, the offeror should describe how their delivery/performance exceeded contract delivery requirements. For verification purposes, the offeror shall furnish a point of contact/name, phone number, contract number and dollar value of recent, relevant contracts.
